Rest time blanket: will be needed, it should be small and thin. No pillows

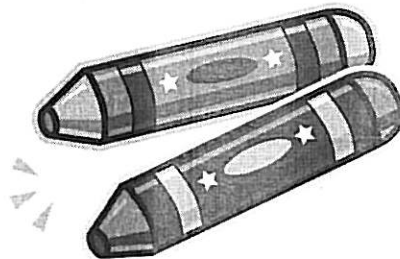
Yellow T-shirt: These T-shirts will be used to wear over clothing for field trips.

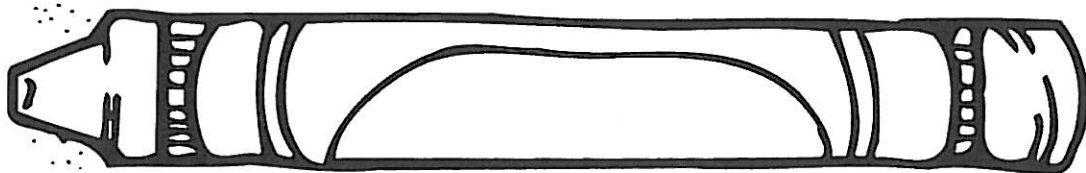

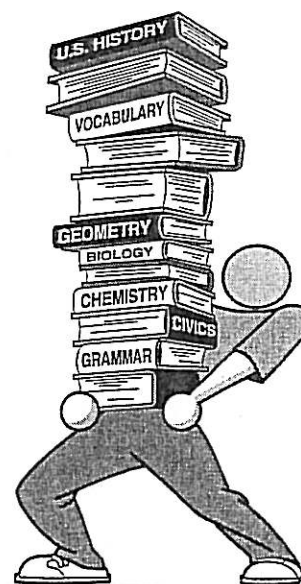
